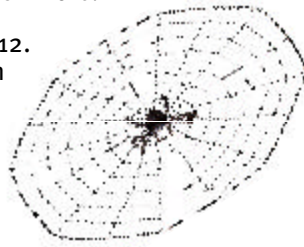


Annual Halloween Party Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center Open to Rock Island residents.

For approximately \$18 and 2 hours of volunteer service (at schools, churches, or other organizations), participants receive \$28-\$30 worth of food and may pay with food stamps. Food is distributed one Friday or Saturday of each month.

S.H.A.R.E. is a community based, self help program which builds community through service and the distribution of a monthly food package. For \$18 and 2 hours of volunteer service, participants can receive a wide variety of food with a retail value of up to \$36 (some sites may ask for \$1 extra for host site expenses). The food packages include: frozen meats, fresh fruits, fresh vegetables, grocery items, and a monthly newsletter that provides more information and recipes.
