WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

School contact in the event of student or volunteer absence:

- **School contact email & phone:**
 - Call school office (563) 723-6400. Tell the school secretary your name and name of the student you were to meet with. The secretary will pass along the information to the teacher and student.
- **What should a volunteer in the event they cannot attend their volunteer time:**
 - Call school office (563) 723-6400 and let the secretary know what time you are able to come in.

How will the school communicate a student absence to a volunteer:

- If the volunteer's assigned student is absent, we will have a "back-up" student to take their place for that day/session.

Parking:

- Please park in the main parking lot (facing Ridgeview Street). You will see a lot of cars also parked here. Go around to the front doors (that face Pacific Street). Press the call button and the office will buzz you in.

Check in:

- When you enter the building you will come right into the front office. The secretary will scan your license and give you a visitors badge.

COVID requirements

- Mask wearing is OPTIONAL and not required. We ask that if you are ill that you please reschedule your visit.

Connecting with your student:

- During your first visit/session with your student, you will be greeted by Courtney Evans (reading specialist) or another staff member to show you where to pick up your student. We will also share with you the rooms/locations you can go to work with your student.



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READING and WRITING GOALS

Share your schools reading goals (improve comprehension, fluency, word recognition, etc.)

- To increase overall reading proficiency. This includes:
 - Reading books (to an adult) that students can practice their decoding (sounding out skills).
 - To listen to high level/high interest stories (being read by an adult) to increase vocabulary and background knowledge.
 - For students to have the opportunity to apply their phonics skills to writing.
 - Students will write about what they have read or listened to.

Reading tips:

- When a student is reading aloud to an adult, the adult will encourage the student to sound out the unknown words.
- When a student is writing words that they are unfamiliar with, encourage them to stretch the word out (orally) and write the sounds they hear.
- When a student is reading aloud to an adult and they make an error. The adult will stop the student and ask they go back and use their decoding skills to sound out the word and try again.
- When the student or adult is reading, the adult will stop at sections of the book to check for understanding. Ask questions:
 - Who is the story about
 - What is happening in the story
 - What does this story make you think about or wonder?
 - Tell me about a time when you had this experience or read a different story like this one.
