- **How will the school communicate a student absence to a volunteer:**

Parking:

- There is street parking out front. Volunteers may park in the bus lane since they will not be here at a time that busses will be coming.

Check in:

- Volunteers will need to be scanned in on their first visit with their driver's license. Each following visit they will check-in and be given a name tag.

COVID requirements

- If a volunteer tests positive they will need to quarantine for 5 days and then mask for an additional 5 days

Connecting with your student:

- Cindy will provide a space in room 41 for volunteers to meet with their student and will ensure the student knows where to go
- Students will also be bringing their lunch with them so potentially listening while they eat and then having a turn being the reader when they are finished eating.
