RISE UNITED 2030 GOALS

United Way has collaborated with community partners to develop a set of 10-year targets to drive transformative change and advance racial equity in the areas of education, income and health. To achieve this aspiration, we focus on three key levers to drive progress.

- ▶ **Increase to 80%** the number of students reading on grade level by third grade.
- ▶ **Increase by 20%** the number of young adults earning living wages, adding \$116M in wages per year to the economy.
- ▶ **Increase to 95%** the percent of Quad Citizens reporting having routine health care.
