Why it matters: This makes young scholars 4x more likely to graduate high school.

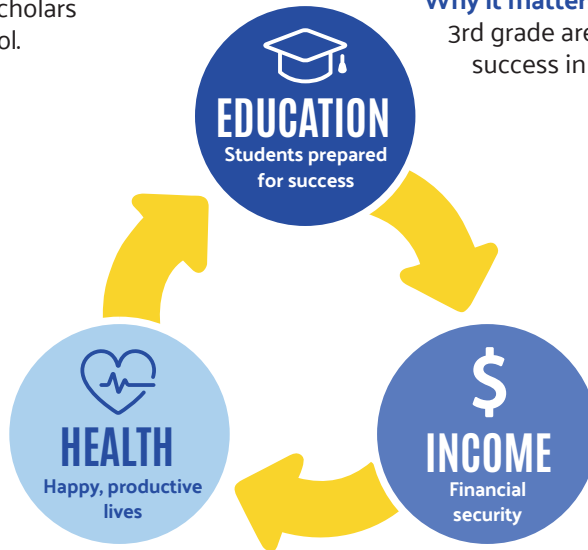
\$36 can provide a child with 12 books a year, preparing them for school and early reading.

Vision To Learn

\$185 can give a struggling learner in low-income neighborhood the eye glasses they need to see clearly and succeed in school.

Why it matters: Nearly 1 out of 3 QC students don't have the glasses they need to see the board, read a book or participate in class.



Dollars for College

\$50 can fund a child's college savings account, which can grow to nearly \$500 by high school graduation.

Why it matters: Children with a college savings account are 3x more likely to attend college and 4x more likely to graduate.

Student Journey to Economic Mobility

\$500 can provide six months of intensive one-on-one counseling for an elementary-age student.

Why it matters: Early interventions like this can increase kids' chances of achieving in school, graduating, enrolling in college or training, and building a promising career.

Pathways to Work

\$350 can provide career training materials that can help a Quad Citian get certified for a good-paying job.

Why it matters: Training and certification can help neighbors in need build financial stability by increasing their earnings by an average of \$6,300.
